2022 was a fantastic summer of cricket, helped by the endless sunny weather. Cricket in Bucks showed growth across so many areas: All Stars, Dynamos, Junior Competitions, Coaches qualified, Pathway fixtures, Street Cricket projects and Disability Hubs.

As ever, the game is indebted to the hard work and enthusiasm of our Clubs volunteers to making all of this happen up and down the country, day in day out across a hectic summer with no respite.

The work has progressed towards the merger of the Cricket Board and County Club into a single 'Bucks Cricket' entity. Stewarded by Ian Hodgson, who is Chair of both organisations, this will complete in 2023.

It was great to be at High Wycombe CC as the Men's 1st XI beat Surrey in the inaugural National County Showcase fixture, and at Chalfont St. Peter CC as the Women's team beat Sussex by over 100 runs in the South Central Cup, a new initiative with the regional team Southern Vipers.

As an organisation we are now up to 11 staff, with a view to a couple more roles to be filled over the winter. We said goodbye this year to Ed Page, Shaz Khan and Hannah Mansell. Joe Rance (Development Officer), Samina Mehrab (Inclusion Officer), Rachel Hudson (Operations & Comms) and Muhsin Raquib (Community Cricket Manager) have joined. James Savory has become Junior Pathway Manager and George Morris' role has become Milton Keynes focused to provide coaching in Secondary Schools and more support to Clubs growing their junior sections in the city.

We have some fantastic foundations for us all to build on for Cricket in Buckinghamshire in 2023.

# Player Pathway - Season Highlights



## Boys team highlights include:

U18s beat Oxfordshire by an innings and 122 runs in the new ECB 3 day comp.

U16s beat Leics by 98 runs and Notts by 43 runs.

U15s beat Berkshire by 6 wkts and Herts by 131 runs.

U14s beat Warwickshire by 55 runs and Staffs by 115 runs.

U13s beat Somerset by 6 wkts and Northants by 5 wkts.

U12s won 4 out of 5 games on the Minor Counties Festival in Ipswich.

New regional structure ran at B11-13 as well as U14 Development team.

## Girls team highlights include:

U18s beat Surrey by 65 runs and Essex by 4 runs.

U15s won the most ECB T20 fixtures in the country.

U13s won 76% of fixtures including vs all bordering counties and the Netherlands.

U11s beat Worcs by 7 runs and beat all bordering counties.

Development teams also ran out all age groups.




